PPC DOCKET

- Litigants learn the possible reactions their children may experience during the separation or divorce.
- Goal is to establish a Temporary Order Agreement:
 - Plan parenting time
 - Compute child support
- May refer to Trial Judge for a Temporary Order Hearing
- Identify High Conflict cases.
- Receive Scheduling Order provides cases with statutory time frames to complete the following:
 - Parent Education Seminar "Helping Children Cope with Divorce"

3 weeks

- Discovery
- Mediation
- Exchange written settlement offers
- 120 Day Status Conference date with the assigned Judge

PARENT EDUCATION SEMINAR

"Helping Children Cope with Divorce"

MEDIATION

90 day waiting period is over = 3 months

120 DAY STATUS CONFERENCE

Status conference with assigned Judge.

Filing Petition to 120 Day Status Conference = 5 months

PRE-TRIAL CONFERENCE

- Must complete the Parent Education Seminar, Discovery, and Mediation before a Pre-Trial Conference can be set.
- The "Request To Set Case For Pre-Trial Conference" form must be submitted to get a Pre-Trial Conference date.
- Trial cannot be set until the Pre-Trial Conference has been completed.
