Pursuant to the National Emergency Declaration by The President of The United States and the First Emergency Joint Order Regarding the COVID-19, entered by the Supreme Court of the State of Oklahoma and the Oklahoma Court of Criminal Appeals, (SCAD NO. 2020-24), and by the District Judges present at an emergency meeting of the Tulsa District Court Judges held March 19, 2020, the following are Orders of The District Court of Tulsa County:

1. This Order is effective immediately and remains in full force and effect until April 20, 2020.
2. All judicial offices and courts are closed. Judges and staff are authorized to work remotely, as they see fit.
3. Judges available on telephone call for emergencies, are as follows:


